

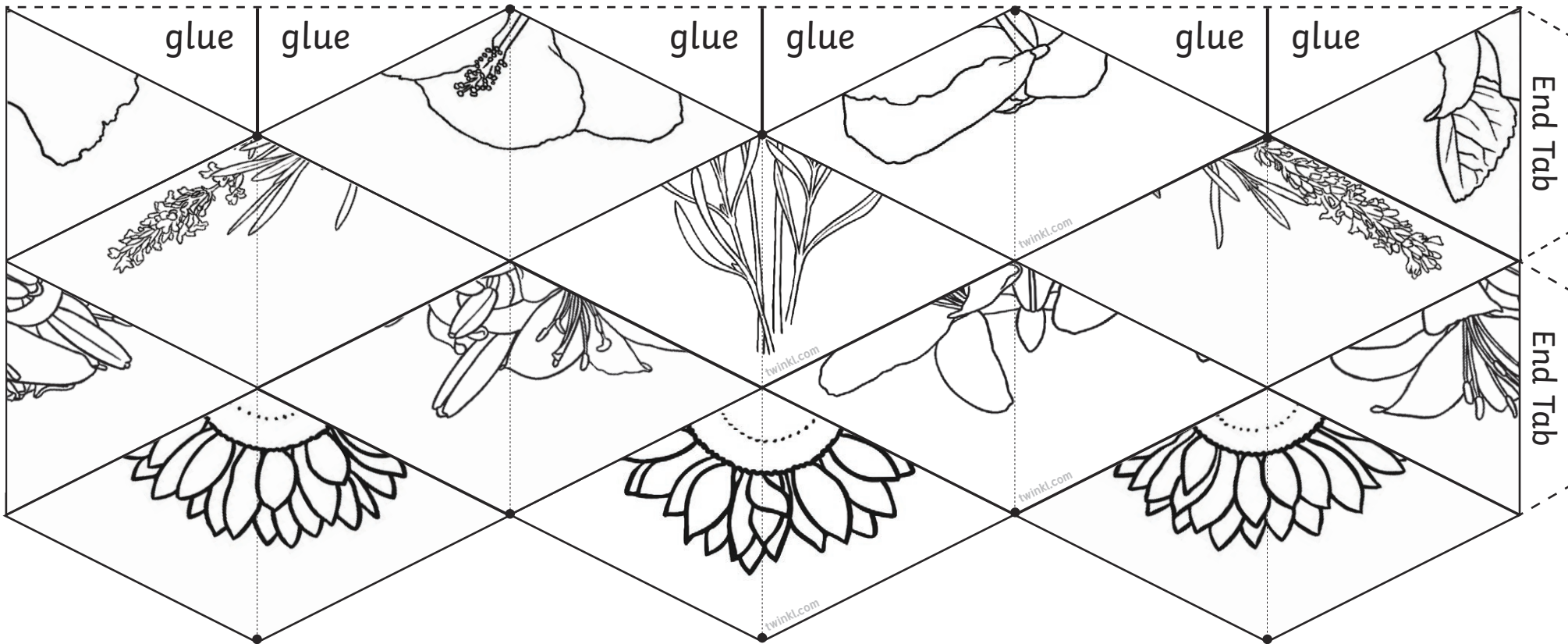
Flexangles

Instructions

1. Colour in each triangle of the flexangle. Make sure each triangle in a row is coloured in using the same colours. Each row can be different to one another, to make different patterns. All of the triangles in row 'A' should look the same, all of the triangles in row 'B' should look the same, and so on.
2. Cut the whole flexangle template out around the edge.
3. Fold the dashed vertical lines towards you (a "valley" fold). Crease them well, then unfold to make the flexangle flat again.
4. Next, fold all of the diagonal lines away from you (a "mountain" fold) and crease them well. Make sure you fold both diagonals! Unfold the flexangle again.
5. Carefully wrap the flexangle into a tube, matching dot to dot, forming a tube shape.
6. Add glue to the tabs marked GLUE and press the tube together.
7. Add glue to the end tab and tuck it into the open end of the tube. Press the ends together to make it strong.
8. Let your glue dry and then test out your flexangle! Can you see all of your different patterns?
