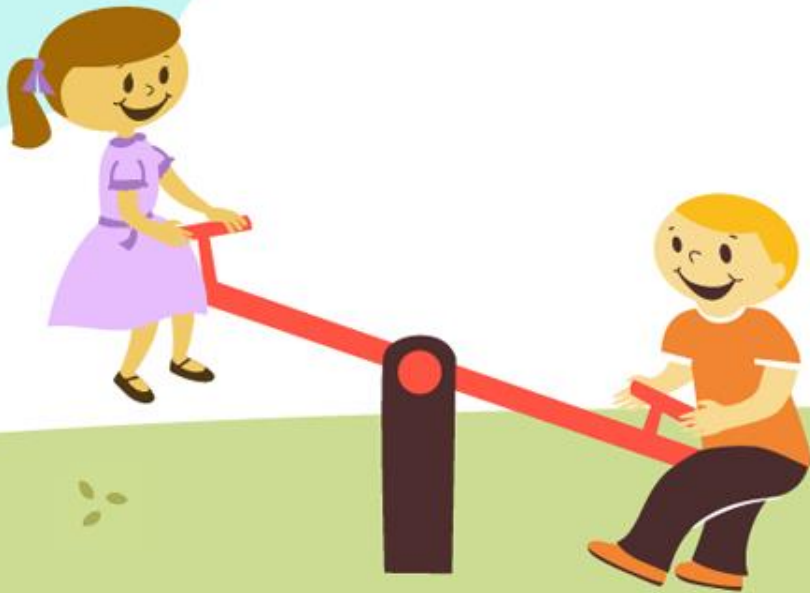
At 3:30 in the video, take a moment to think about when you felt loved!

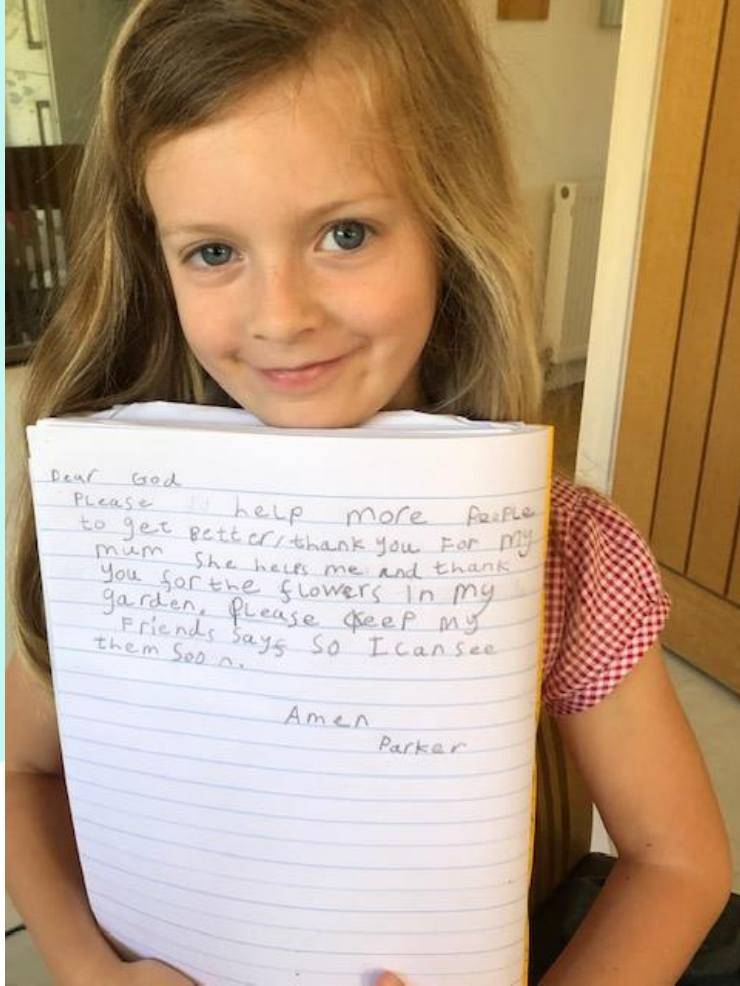


Thought of the Day
