What do 'R' learning values look like?

Although it is important that you learn new skills and knowledge, it is also very important to learn to be better at learning itself! There are 6 special words that we use at Verwood First School and Nursery and these words describe things that we need to have to be successful learners whatever type of learning we're doing!

Respect - thinking of the feelings of others

Responsibility – to do the things you are expected to do and accept the consequences (results) of your actions

Resilience – enjoy the feeling of learning

Reflectiveness – take charge of your learning

Reciprocity – learning with and from others

Resourcefulness – thinking in different ways

This week we would like you to focus on just one of the above and complete some of the following activities.

* Can you recommend a storybook that demonstrates your chosen R? Write a book review.

(For example, we recommend 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers. This story is about a little boy who loves stars so much he decides to catch one. The boy keeps on trying but does he accomplish his goal?)

- **❖** Can you create a bright poster that represents an R of your choice − be as creative as you like!
 - ***** Write an acrostic poem about your chosen R.
- **Create a word web. How many words can you think of that links to your chosen R?**
 - **❖** Can you role play and then write about a famous person or someone inspirational who has demonstrated your chosen R?
 - **Can you write a personal diary entry about when you have had to be resilient, resourceful etc.?**
 - **Can you create a collage of images showing your chosen R?**
