Dear Parents/Carers

During our Inset days at the beginning of September, Verwood staff were involved in a review of our Behaviour Guidance. This guidance has been updated, shared and agreed at school level and I am now able to share this document with you.

We have three trust wide behaviour expectations:-

- 1) readiness to learn
- 2) respectful relationships
- 3) engagement

The guidance fits closely with our 6R's expectations and our Fruit of the Spirit values. During the first few weeks of term we have been teaching the children explicitly our behaviour expectations and linking to our values for life, which our children know and understand.

We have agreed to no longer use the sun images and pegs in the classroom but have increased the number of weekly awards in Praise Worship each Friday to include Fruit of the Spirit Awards and a Headteacher's award. To reward classroom behaviours, each class collects gemstones and works towards a collective reward once the jar is full.
