Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back to the Spring Term 2024 and Happy New Year . I hope you have all had an enjoyable Christmas break and are ready for the busy year ahead! On behalf of all the staff, I would like to thank you for all your kind wishes and messages at the end of last term.

Staff returned to school on Tuesday with an excellent training day working with staff from Hillside and St John's First Schools. Our focus was ensuring that all children are engaged with learning. We use Rosenshine's Principles of teaching and Tom Sherrington's Walk Thru techniques to review and focus our teaching strategies and develop how we question and give time for children to think about and share their thinking. We also took time to review our behaviour guidance and learn from our analysis of monitoring from the autumn term.

We have loved having the children return to school on Wednesday. I have been very impressed as I have moved around the school to see each class ready to learn, showing excellent learning behaviours and enjoying new learning topics. Thank you for your support with ensuring that they have the correct uniform and shoes and arriving on time. Classroom doors and the playground gate close at 8.45am and after this point children will need to come into school via the main entrance. Thank you for your support with children being in class, ready to learn at 8.45am.

This term we are trialling teachers remaining in the classrooms in the morning as we welcome children at 8.30am and a teaching assistant on the door for messages. This is to provide a smooth start to the school day as children arrive in the classroom. Any messages for school can be shared through parentmail as well as to the adult on the door.

I would also like to remind families that children should not be bringing into school any toys from home. With lots of new and exciting toys over Christmas, please ensure they stay at home where they are kept safe.

Last term we advertised for a new gate attendant to man the main campus gates. Unfortunately we have not been successful at recruiting for this position. We therefore kindly request that only parents/family members who have been allocated with permission drive onto the campus to drop off or collect children. Some members of staff start work at 8.45am or 9am and we must ensure that there is sufficient parking for them. Thank you for your understanding that we continue to keep the traffic flow on campus to a minimum for the safety of pupils, families and staff. If you have requested permission you will be contacted today with your pass.

In today's newsletter are many dates of events happening this term and into the summer term. We are introducing a new event this term, **Celebrate your child's learning.** Please save the date **Thursday 8th February** when parents and carers are invited into their child's class at 2.30 - 3.00pm to allow your child to share their books and learning with you. We know the children will be excited and proud to share their learning with you.
