Staff Training Day - 19th February


Teaching staff enjoyed an engaging training day on Monday, focused on the theme of *checking for understanding* through embedding and honing our core questioning techniques. These include, 'Think Pair Share' and 'Cold Calling' and using mini (show me) whiteboards for pupils to show their understanding.


With evidence-based research at the heart of all our professional training, we discussed the 'learning model' and the limitations of working memory and challenges of ensuring pupils can embed new learning into their

long-term memory. Skilled questioning techniques are the bedrock of effective responsive teaching - supporting children to think, make meaning and address common misconceptions across the curriculum. Knowing more is remembering more and our goal is always for pupils to develop vast bodies of connected knowledge over time.
