#### **Church School Vision review**

Last term we began a church school vision review with children, families, staff and our LSC reflecting on 'What does it mean to belong to Verwood First School and Nursery?' A core group of leaders have looked at the feedback and reflected upon how to develop a vision that is meaningful to everyone. Key themes which have arisen from our discussions with children, staff, families and LSC are: <u>light</u> and <u>hope</u>. This is where we need your help!

Today we are sharing with you and the children in class a letter asking families to think about how we can **Be Light and Hope**. How could these themes be represented? What does it mean to you? #### Staffing update

At this point in the year we are starting to consider staff for the next academic year. This is also a time when some staff may choose to further professional or personal interest and move on from school. At the end of this term we will be saying a fond farewell to Miss Matthew and Miss Spencer from Oak Base. Miss Matthew has secured a leadership position in a Poole school and Miss Spencer is going to begin an adventure in Australia as a teacher. They are fantastic colleagues who will be greatly missed by staff and families but we wish them well for the future. I am delighted to share with you the exciting news that Mrs Elle Brason, who currently teaches in Beech Base will be leading the Nursery and Reception Base as early years lead from September. Mrs Brason has a passion for early years and is very excited about developing our Early Years provision. Miss Matthew and Mrs Brason have this term to work together on transition arrangements and new children starting school in September. In addition, we are saying goodbye at half term to teaching assistant Nicola Christopher. Mrs Christopher has secured a position at Beaucroft school. Although we are very sad to say goodbye to Mrs Christopher we wish her all the best.

This term is very busy and there are already some fantastic events for the children. Today every child in the school is participating in a cricket engagement day. Thank you to Dorset Cricket who are giving everyone a chance to learn more about this sport and give it a try. We have also had Dorset music service come and work with Ash base. They are working with Samba drums and have already made a fantastic start working together to learn rhythms and techniques. We are proud to have been awarded an Eco-Schools Green Flag accreditation for 3 consecutive years and our Eco Team are now in the process of applying for our fourth! At the start of each academic year the Eco Team completes an 'Environmental Review' - this helps us to identify our 3 areas to focus on. This year our development areas are **saving energy, reducing litter** and **encouraging biodiversity** within our school grounds. Our Eco Team consists of a group of 25 children who are supported by Mrs Steel - they will keep you updated on this year's application for our fourth Green Flag award! Our Eco team
