Please take some time to look at the site with your child and explore. The site is completely e-safe and does not have any external links, except for one to CBBC news, so once comfortable your child can safely explore on their own.

Here are some ideas to get them started:

- Play the quizzes to test your knowledge! The **interactive quiz** 'Umbuzo' is being played by thousands of children every day. It not only engages children in lessons, but is being used as an assessment tool by teachers too.
- Explore the written content under '**Explore the World**' - investigate a country or a physical feature. Take a journey through the world by clicking on the green hyperlinks and seeing where they take you.

At school we will be using an additional feature called "ClassPals" which enables us to link up with other classrooms around the world. ClassPals is not available at home with the above login details, but your child may talk about sending and receiving postcards. This system is monitored by the teacher at all times and is completely e-safe.
