School Closure

I write to you following the government's announcement that all schools will close to most pupils from the end of the school day on Friday 20th March. Schools will remain open for the children of key workers and vulnerable children.

Parents and carers have been contacted to identify themselves to their schools as key workers. We will be in contact to make arrangements for Monday.

Parents and carers of vulnerable children will be contacted this week to make arrangements for Monday.

During the closure, we will provide home learning for all pupils which will be uploaded to Tapestry for Nursery and Reception children and the website for all other age groups of children for learning to complete. Staff will be available to track and monitor completion of the work. It is important for students to engage meaningfully with this work, which will consolidate and build on current knowledge.

Statutory assessments for all key stages including exams for year 6, year 11 and year 13 will not take place.
