## Solve subtraction two-step problems

- 1) I think of a number, add 2 and then add another 34. The answer is 54. What was my number?
- 2) A box holds 60 Belgian chocolates. How many chocolates are left if Dale eats 13 and Bartek eats 22?
- 3) In Sam's Sandwich Shop, there are **342** freshly made sandwiches. Sam sells **123** ham sandwiches and **108** cheese sandwiches. How many sandwiches are left?
- 4) There are 32 children at a party. Half of them are wearing a red top. Ten of them are wearing a blue top. If the rest are wearing a green top, how many are wearing a green top?
- 5) On Tuesday, **224** males and **286** females visited the museum. This is **124** more people than visited on Monday. How many more people visited the museum on Monday?
- 6) At the DVD shop, there are **143** movie DVDs and **79** comedy DVDs for sale. If the shop sells **70** DVDs, how many do they have left?
