Make a beautiful sun catcher cross, using paper and coloured tissue paper.



Have your own egg and spoon race in your garden with the rest of your family.



Hard boil an egg, then colour/paint the eggshell to symbolise the message of Easter. You can stand it up on an eggcup and pop it in your window for others to see.



Create an Easter egg hunt for the rest of the family, you could write/draw your own clues and leave a trail of them around the house or garden. Then get them to do one for you!



Play 'Bunny, Bunny, RABBIT!', an Easter variation of Duck, Duck, Goose.



Make egg shakers. Half fill some plastic eggs with rice, beans or lentils, then glue/selotape the two egg halves together. Why not make a variety of egg shakers, each with different sounds?
